


Alessandro

Alessandro Tognin, painter, born in Occhiobello on 5 June 1981, moved by his passion for painting and color, he reflects the expression on canvas of his emotions in the engaging brushstrokes of his paintings. His creative power manifests itself already in adolescence and lately is being released, making the techniques of acrylic on canvas his own with shapes that are not always simple and pure colors, typical of his expressive intensity. Influenced by everything that catches the attention of his eye: landscapes, portraits, rural scenes, expresses the faces of imaginary characters and

even abstract objects, according to the inner light that captures you. Alessandro Tognin's paintings are never trivial because they collect a variety of expressions and traits, typical of an observer eye that captures the wonders of the reality that surrounds it, transforming them into abstract paintings of considerable artistic intensity. The creative vein is sensitive to the emotions dictated by a spring flower, a lunar atoll, the universe that surrounds us. The primary colors fight each other in his paintings to achieve a naive naturalness, rich in warm and cold tones at the same time.






Denn Glück ist die Summe schöner Augenblicke – Die unser Leben bereichern.


Mein Name ist Cornelia Seuß und ich wohne mit meinem Mann und meinen vier Kindern in meiner Heimatstadt Dachau bei München.
